

Overview of Math Expectations

Homework Grading and Expectations

- Almost all assignments are worth 10 points
- 10% off if late
- Must be done in pencil, or will result in 0 points. The student may recopy the assignment for late credit
- Incomplete = 0 points until completed for late credit
- Redo = $\frac{1}{2}$ credit until you redo the assignment for full credit
- Being able to communicate mathematically in an organized way is essential for math success, so all work must be shown or 0 points. Student can redo for late credit.
- Assignments must be neat, organized and legible. If Mrs. Stoel can't read the assignment she can't grade it. This will result in 0 points; the student can redo the assignment for late credit.

FOR ALL Assignments students must

- Must have name, section number, problem numbers, answer column
- Show work
- Completed in pencil
- Answers to ALL word problems must be in sentence form.

Calculators

- I typically do not allow 6th graders to use a calculator
- 7th/8th/Algebra can usually use a calculator. They still need to show adequate work, but it is very helpful with the basic calculations.

Extra Help

Students can always get extra help from Mrs. Stoel The student must communicate with me so that I can help them find a time that will work with their schedule.

- Before school from 8:00-8:30
- After school from 3:20-4:00, or later with parent/teacher approval
- Virtual Learning: We can schedule an individual zoom by appt.

DreamBox

These programs will be able to help students either fill gaps or excel in their math knowledge. The programs can adapt and assign content in real-time without a teacher manually assigning content. I review student work and paths regularly to ensure the program stays on the right track. It also helps me identify areas I need to work one-on-one with a student.
